SERVICES AND SKILLS

SCOREKEEPER:

Keeps track of scores and records results or operates a scoreboard. Will train.

GAMES SET-UP:

Assist in setting up games such as laying tape to establish ball courts, set-up archery field, lay shuffleboard courts, set-up washer pitch boards, set-up horseshoe playing space, etc. Previous experience NOT required.

OFFICIALS/ REFEREES :

Person who enforces the rules in certain sporting events.

STARTER:

Is an official who is authorized to start an event with a gun or strong audible device.

RUNNER:

Runs to get what ever is needed by the chair or official (also, could be asked to be a ball chaser).

TIMER:

Person actually timing an event of athlete operates a stop watch or a timing device (could be asked to measure distances as well).

JUDGE:

Professional person authorized to judge a particular event or sport.

GENERAL VOLUNTEER:

Help with general duties for a certain sport or with administrative tasks. Previous experience NOT required.
