SERVICE AND SKILLS

SCOREKEEPER:

Keeps track of scores and records results or operates a scoreboard. Will train.

GAMES SET-UP:

Assist in setting up games such as laying tape, laying down shuffleboard courts, set-up washer pitch boards, set-up horseshoes, load/unload truck

OFFICIALS/REFEREES:

Person who enforces the rules in certain sporting events.

STARTER:

Is an official who is authorized to start an event with a gun or strong audible device.

Runner:

Runs to get whatever is needed by the chair or official (also could be asked to be a ball chaser).

TIMER:

Person actually timing an event, operates a stop watch or other device (could also be asked to mark distances)

JUDGE:

Professional person authorized to judge a particular event or sport

GENERAL VOLUNTEER:

Help with general duties for a certain sport or with administrative tasks.
