LSOG member, **Trent Lane**, has been named **Michelob Ultra Geezerjock of the Year** in the Men's 80+ category. Lane is 95 and resides in Baker, LA. He was one of 12 recipients of this inaugural award. The GeezerJock of the Year award recognizes supreme athletic achievement in masters' sports.
