Adele Mart, the Southwest District Games Coordinator, in the Lake Charles area, was informed January 25 that all events scheduled on the McNeese Campus are cancelled. The campus facilities have been under renovation since Hurricane Rita and were on schedule to be ready for the Southwest District Games.

Construction delays have resulted in the cancellation of only Southwest District Games events scheduled and listed in the entry form on the McNeese Campus.

The LSOG website has an updated entry form listing events that are currently available for the Southwest District Games. Cancelled events have been crossed out on the entry form on our website.
