INFORMATION FOR ALL ENTRANTS

ELIGIBILITY: The Acadiana District Senior Games are open to anyone who is at least 50 years of age by December 31, 2009. Athletes, who are first time participants, are required to submit proof of age with the entry/registration form. The Acadiana games are an OPEN event. Out-of-state residents are eligible and encouraged to participate. All competitors must have their entry forms to the Lafayette Council on Aging office by March 17, 2009. All participants must be registered to participate. Out of District/State must finish in the top 3 to receive an award. Age division for doubles will be determined by the age of the youngest partner. The 2009 Acadiana District Games is a qualifying site for State Senior Games.

DATES: APRIL 17-27, 2009

ENTRY DEADLINE: MARCH 17, 2009

FEES: Entry fee is \$20.00 for first 3 sports: EXAMPLE - Badminton, Golf, Track & Field (3 sports).
ADDITIONAL SPORTS:
Pickleball, The Throws, Swimming, etc. \$2.00 each.
Additional fees: Golf-\$15.00; Bowling-\$8.00; Miniature Golf-\$3.25; XXL or Larger Shirts-\$3.00

DOUBLES / MIXED DOUBLES: Partners need to submit their entry forms in the same envelope.

WEATHERPOLICY: Sports using outdoor sites are weather dependent. Competitions will be conducted unless an Acadiana Senior Games official determines weather conditions to be potentially dangerous or life threatening, or if the playing fields would incur significant damage. **IMPORTANT:** In checking your sports, be sure that you avoid conflicts of times in each sport checked. All times stated are starting times. **SPORTS ARE IN BOLD PRINT.**

GUESTS: Family and friends are welcome to attend all sporting events free of charge.

DISTRICT GAMES are designed to make available additional competition in athletic events already being held at the state level. Each district will not offer all 72 sport categories available at the state games. Athletes must qualify in one of the 2009 District Games to compete in the 2009 State Championship Games in the following events: *Bowling Singles (top three scratch score places); *Men & Women Golf (must meet minimum standard); *Advanced Horseshoes (top three places); *Table Tennis Singles (top three places); *Advanced Shuffleboard, *Discus, *Javelin and *Shot Put (top two places); *Dance Team Competition (two age groups, all teams qualify). Athletes may also qualify by meeting minimum qualifying standards for each starred event.
